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Executive summary

This document aims to provide a brief description of the final conference of the Prima WildFood project. The conference took place on 16th-17th May, in Solsona (Spain) and it was an opportunity to show the results of the project, as well as the Policy Brief.

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1. The structure and the objectives of the Final Conference

The Final conference of the WildFood project has been held on 16th and 17th May, in Solsona (Spain). The event, organized in the context of WP5 of the project, has been coordinated by CTFC team, with the collaboration of all WP leaders. Initially, the conference was planned to be held in Algeria, however, after Algerian partner withdrawal, the place of the conference was changed for Solsona, at CTFC's headquarters as coordinator of the project. The conference aimed to communicate on the wild food sector state of the art and progress, inform on policy recommendations and disseminate the results of the WildFood project.

As described below, the conference was divided into 2 days, and in each of these days various moments of discussion and interaction were organized to encourage the participation of all project partners and other interested stakeholders. It should be emphasized, in fact, that the event was broadcast online and all attendants and participants, even if not physically present, were able to interact with the rest of the audience.

2. The conference participants

As described in Annex 1, 66 participants attended the event, both in-person (35) and online (31). It should also be noted that some speakers were invited as guests of the first day (16th May), as representatives and members of the advisory board (such as Giulia Muir and Sven Mutke). During the second day only members of the consortium partners participated in the field visit. The list of participants that attended the event is attached in the Annex 1.

In the conference the innovative actions carried out in the project were presented. It was eight innovative actions with the aim of improving aspects of quality, safety and sustainability of wild food products and their value chains, such as the preparation of laboratory protocols for the identification and certification of truffles, and also for the monitoring of its production. Another of the actions were the establishment of a new protocol to quantify the production of pineapples, using drones and multispectral sensors, which will allow a more efficient and accurate evaluation of the production of pineapples (and pine nuts) than with the current visual estimation of pineapples. Among other actions, the project has also developed a training program available online, a platform for sector actors in the Mediterranean and



informative and informative material aimed at consumers that was presented in the conference.

Main topics in the WFP value chains have been discussed and main recommendations explained. The main recommendations of the project to improve the definition and regulation of this subsector have been collected in a Policy Brief, available in several languages. Among others, the research team highlights the importance of including some of the wild food plantations (such as truffles) within agricultural activities and being considered as agricultural production and promoting cooperation between producers by creating unique brands and packaging to help distinguish local products from others and increase company recognition in the market. In short, certification and labeling are key elements to provide transparency regarding the safety of wild foods, improve the working conditions of workers in the sector and the protection of forests and biodiversity.


