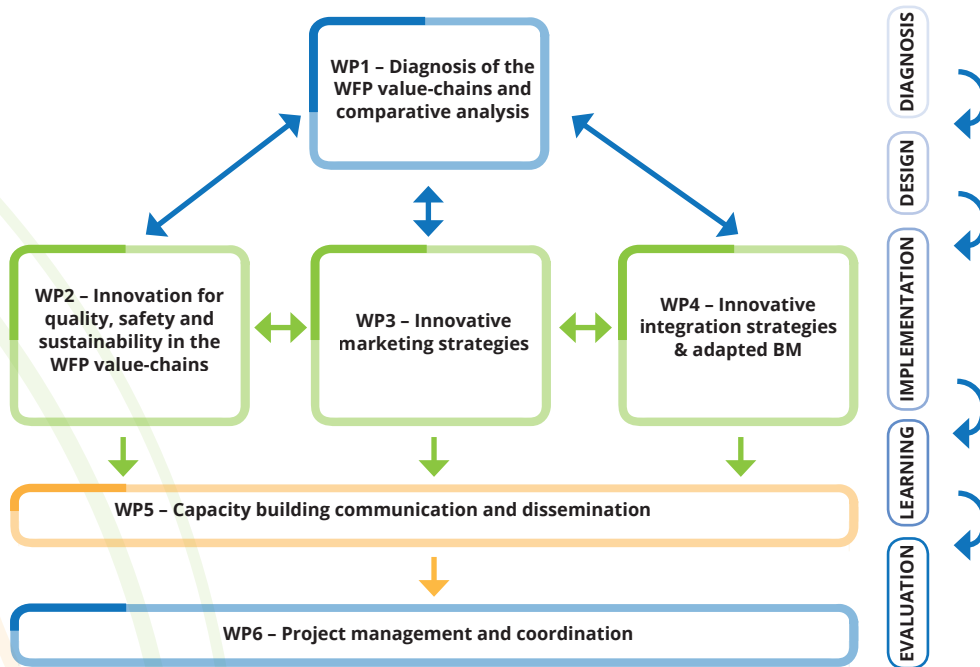

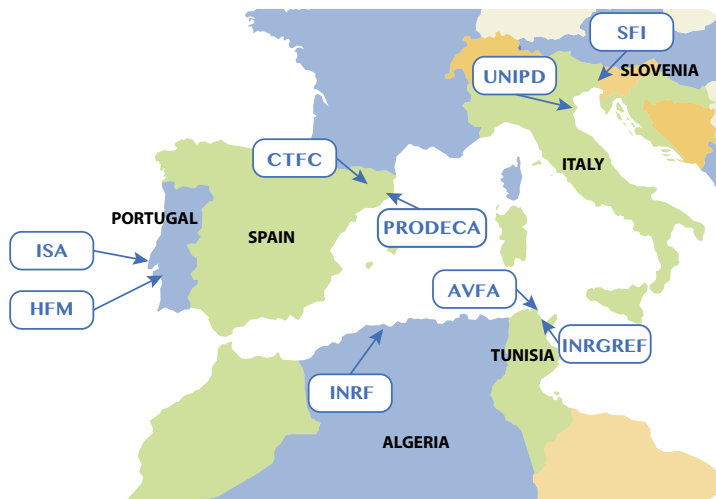
What do we expect?
